


Figure 1- Rodent complaints to public health/vector control/environmental health departments for seven major California counties after rodenticide restrictions.



Data obtained from seven major county public health/vector control/environmental health departments through Public Records Act requests indicates that rodent complaint numbers since the first anticoagulant bill was implemented do not show significant increases in annual complaints. (Figure 1)
